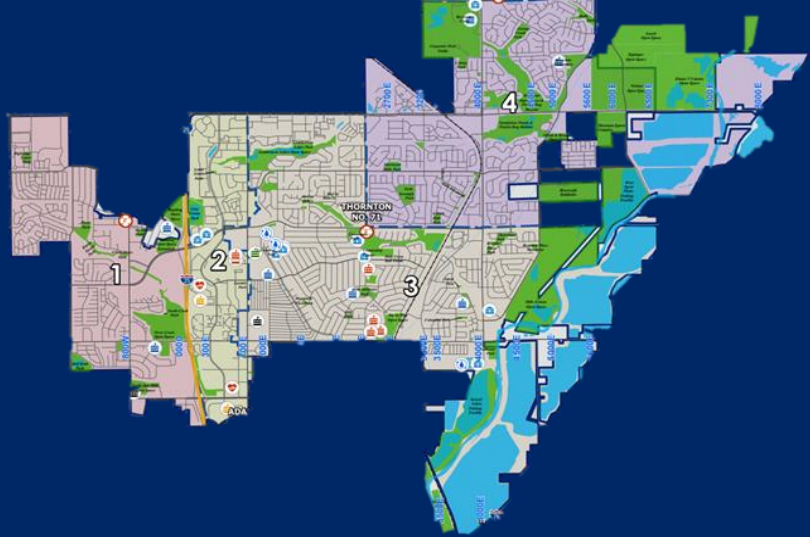

News Release for a Fatal Pedestrian Hit and Run on 03-24-2024 Case Report #2024004420

On March 24th at about 6:00 AM, Thornton Police responded to the 2500 block of westbound E. 120th Avenue on report of a hit and run crash involving a pedestrian. The adult male pedestrian, who had suffered serious injuries, was pronounced deceased on scene. The roadway was closed for several hours as investigators worked to identify the vehicle involved, collect evidence, and conduct the initial investigation.

Currently Thornton Police are looking for a gray car with front end damage.

The identity of the victim is being withheld by the Adams County Coroner's Office, pending positive identification and notification of next of kin. This investigation remains ongoing and active. Anyone with information is asked to call the Thornton PD Tip-Line at (720) 977-5069

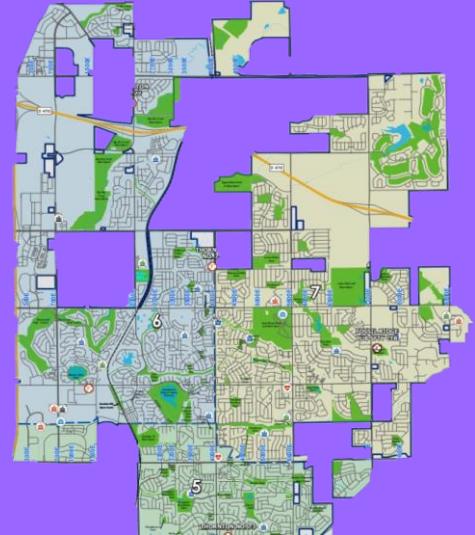
